

THE DOANE PLAN

The Doane Plan, or Doane’s general education requirement, is comprised of approximately 57 credits in a wide range of survey courses. Though quite often individual major requirements will satisfy both the major and the Doane Plan simultaneously, this document lists the CCC courses that will satisfy each facet of the Doane Plan. **Comments in green indicate differences between the Crete campus and the Lincoln/Grand Island campuses.**
