COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers basic digital film editing and production using iMovie 6. Students will make a film on a subject matter of their choosing at least 5 minutes in length. Students will learn the entire process of digital film making including filming, importing, editing, adding music, adding titles, and exporting their finished product to DVD.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Upon satisfactory completion of this course, students will be able to use iMovie to:

1. Use a digital video camera to capture video
2. Import footage from a digital camera into iMovie
3. Import still images into iMovie
4. Create titles and other graphics in Photoshop for use in their film
5. Edit footage in iMovie
6. Add titles, music, transitions and effects to their footage
7. Export their edited footage to DVD
