

MONDAY EVENING

ACC 104 Managerial Accounting - Tremont

Required for Accounting majors. Pre-requisite: ACC 103

ART 234 Intro to Digital Photography – Keller

Fulfills one Aesthetic (Fine Arts) requirement. This course is an introduction to the fundamentals of digital photography, including camera operation; the basic functions of image editing software; and basic principles of photographic aesthetics and composition. Students must provide their own digital camera. The camera required for the course is a Digital Single Lens Reflex (SLR) Camera or an advanced, adjustable Digital Camera (must be able to adjust shutter speeds, apertures and ISO).

BIO 225 Human Anatomy (4) - Staff

Required for people who wish to pursue nursing or other health care programs. This course DOES NOT fulfill the Doane Plan Lab Science requirement.

BUS 497W Bus & Prof Ethics - Dickerson

Required for Accounting, Business, and Communication majors. Fulfills one Liberal Learning requirement for everyone except Business majors.

CMS 316 Business & Prof Communication - Larson

Required for Business, Public Admin, ISM, and Communication majors. Fulfills Doane Plan Oral Communication requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, will fulfill one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement.

CSA 102 Spreadsheets (1) Meets 12/1, 12/8, 12/15.

Required for Accounting, Business, ISM, and Paralegal majors. All students must complete CSA 101 plus one additional credit in computer science.

GRD 237 Multi-Dimensional Design -Krieger

Fulfills one Doane Plan Fine Arts requirement. Required for Graphic Design majors.

GRD 271 Beginning Web Design – C. Hadfield

Beginning course in Web design. Students will develop a personal Web page and/or a basic Web site for small business. This course is a pre-requisite for Graphic Design II.

HIS 206 History of US after 1877 – Duncan

Fulfills Doane Plan History requirement.

Doane Plan requirement.

ISM 102 Software Development II – Millet

Required for ISM majors. Pre-requisite ISM 101.

MTH 115 Finite Math - Grothen (meets Mon & Thurs)

Required for Accounting and Business majors. Pre-requisite: MTH 105 or MTH 108

PRE 323W Religion in American Life – Tasey

Fulfills Doane Plan Philosophy/Religion requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, fulfills one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement.

PSY 365W Psychology of Personality – Kilnoski

Required for Human Relations majors. Fulfills Doane Plan Psychology/Sociology requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, will fulfill one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement for everyone.

SOC 336W Social Psychology - Allen

Required for Human Relations majors. Fulfills one requirement for Comm and Public Admin majors. Fulfills one Doane Plan Contemporary Issues requirement OR one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement.

THE 112 Oral Interpretation – Mattran

Fulfills one Doane Plan Aesthetic/Fine Arts requirement.

ACC 104 Managerial Accounting - Tremont

Required for Accounting majors. Pre-requisite: ACC 103

ACC 332 Advanced Accounting II - Johnson

Required for Accounting majors. Pre-requisite: ACC 331.

ANT 308W Cultural Anthropology – B. Hayes

Fulfills Doane Plan International/Multicultural requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, fulfills one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement.

ART 221 Ceramics – LaBar

Fulfills one Doane Plan Fine Arts requirement. This is a beginning course in ceramics. All work is done in studio, with emphasis given to methods of making pottery – slab, coil, and wheel-thrown. This class will meet at Lux Art Center, 2601 N. 48th Street.

ART 235 Color Theory & Application - Krieger

Required for Graphic Design majors. Fulfills one Doane Plan Fine Arts requirement.

ART 271 Introduction to Jewelry Arts – Starkle

This is a beginning course in the art of jewelry making and will fulfill one Doane Plan Fine Arts requirement. The class will meet at Lux Art Center, 2601 N. 48th Street.

BIO 101 Introduction to Biology (4) – Staff

Fulfills Doane Plan Lab Science requirement.

BUS 205W Business Writing – JS Engebretson

Required for Accounting, Business, and Org Communication majors. Fulfills one elective for the ISM major.

BUS 312 Advanced Human Resource Mgt – Kostner

Required for students completing the Human Resource emphasis of the Business major. Fulfills one requirement for the General Business emphasis. Pre-requisite: BUS 212

Doane Plan requirement

GRD 241 Graphic Design & Layout – C. Hadfield

Required for Graphic Design majors.

HRE 371 Med/Psychosocial Aspects Addictions – Speck

Required for Nebraska Drug/Alcohol counselor certification.

HRE 417 Multicultural Counseling – Kastens

Required for Human Relations majors. Prerequisite: PSY 234

IDS 206W Introduction to Research - Christiansen

Required for everyone except ParaLegal Studies majors.

ISM 409 Project Management - Millet

Required for Information Systems Management majors. May be used by Business majors to substitute for BUS 354 Operations Management. Fulfills one Liberal Learning requirement for everyone EXCEPT ISM majors.

PLS 315 Wills, Trusts, & Estates – Hoffman

Required for ParaLegal Studies majors. Fulfills one Liberal Learning requirement for everyone EXCEPT ParaLegal majors.

PRE 120W Understand the Old Testament –Johnston

Fulfills Philosophy/Religion requirement.

PSI 101 American Politics – L. Hadfield

Required for Public Administration and Liberal Arts Studies majors. Fulfills one Doane Plan Contemporary Issues requirement.

SPA 101 Elementary Spanish I – Francis

Fulfills Doane Plan International/Multicultural requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, will fulfill one requirement in the Liberal Learning category of the Doane Plan.

Fulfills one Fine Arts requirement.

ART 358 Art, Issues, Controversies – Kreimer

Required for Graphic Design majors. Fulfills one Doane Plan Fine Arts requirement.

AST 103 Introductory Astronomy – Ehrman

Fulfills one Doane Plan Science requirement. This is NOT a lab science.

BIO 371 Natural History of Nebraska (3) - Staff

Fulfills one Doane Plan Liberal Learning requirement. Topics include natural history of Nebraska; the Sandhills, the Platte, the Ogallala aquifer, Sandhill Cranes migration, life of the prairie.

BUS 315 Organizational Behavior - Hill

Fulfills one Business major emphasis requirement for Management, HR Mgt, and Gen Bus emphases. Fulfills one Public Admin Cognate requirement.

BUS 342 Business Law II – Hoffman

Required for Accounting majors and ParaLegal Studies majors.

CMS 105 Fundamentals of Communication - Mattran

Fulfills Doane Plan Oral Communication requirement. Required for ParaLegal Studies majors.

CMS 321W Intercultural Communication - Dickerson

Required for Communication majors. Fulfills Doane Plan International/Multicultural requirement. If not used to fulfill that requirement, may be used to fulfill one course requirement for Doane Plan Liberal Learning.

GRD 258 Intro to Computer Graphics – C. Hadfield

Required for Graphic Design majors.

HRE 315 Group Counseling - Kastens

Required for Human Relations majors. Prerequisite: CMS 112

ISM 271 Database Application Develop – A. Engbretson

Serves as an ISM elective.

ISM 342 Network Management - Millet

Required for ISM majors. Prerequisites: ISM 102, ISM 253

MTH 108 Modeling/Application - Hertzler

Fulfills Doane Plan Math requirement. Pre-requisite: Math competency (MTH 108 is a prerequisite for MTH 115 Finite Math.)
