MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Family & Community Education Association of Douglas-Sarpy County offers a \$500 scholarship as a means of encouraging students to continue college work beyond the freshman year.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The applicant must be a resident of Douglas or Sarpy County.
2. The applicant shall have completed at least one year of college work by June of the current year and be of sophomore standing or above. Graduate level is eligible.

MAKING APPLICATION

1. The applicant shall use forms provided for making application for the scholarship.
2. The application must be on file with the Douglas-Sarpy County Extension Office, 8015 West Center Road, Omaha, NE 68124 by May 15.
3. Two or more letters of recommendation must accompany the application, one of which being from an instructor in chosen field.
4. A previous recipient of the Family and Community Education Scholarship may re-apply and be considered in the same manner as other applicants.
5. A resume in story form by applicant must be included.
6. A copy of your cumulative grade point from the college you attend must be included.

SELECTION OF WINNER

1. Members of the Global Literacy/Scholarship Committee of the FCE Council (not related to the applicant) shall select a winner and an alternate by June 1. Should the committee desire it, personal interviews may be required.
2. The winner shall be notified by mail or phone.
3. The winner shall accept in writing by June 15.

PRESENTATION AND PAYMENT

1. The winners shall be presented at the summer meeting of the Family & Community Education Association of Douglas-Sarpy County.
2. Each scholarship shall be paid to the student and the college they are attending.
3. The scholarship must be used the year it is presented, and at least a "C" average must be maintained.
