The Mace

Doane University Banner

The Doane University banner bears the seal created by Thomas Doane, Esq. and David Brainerd Perry, the first president of the college. The woman (science) trims the lamp of knowledge to light the book (Bible).

The star and cross are Christian symbols indicating Doane's Congregational heritage. Science faces west to signify westward movement of learning. The triangle denotes strength through three aspects of life: spiritual, physical, and intellectual.

Hoods & Gowns

In academia, different styles of gowns, hoods and colors reveal significant academic achievements among students and distinguish degree levels.

The bachelor's gown has long, pointed sleeves. The master's gown has crescent-shaped sleeves descending from the elbows. The doctor's robe has very full sleeves with three horizontal bars of velvet on each sleeve and two vertical velvet bars down the middle of the front.

Hoods are the most significant conveyors of degree identification. The master's hood is pointed, and the doctor's hood is rounded at the bottom. The hoods have velvet borders and are lined in silk or satin in the official color of the institution that conferred the degree. The color of the velvet border represents the discipline.

The Doane Hymn is a commencement ceremony tradition. Written by Lucy Fiske Medlar, a congregational school teacher and wife of Doane graduate Arthur Medlar (1906), the lyrics express her reflections following a visit to the campus. A 1921 Doane Owl article echoes a line of the hymn, "Her walls are fitting monuments of those that reared them there," recognizing that "those of the past have certainly left their imprint." May our graduates today feel the imprint they leave behind, as they go forth from these walls and grounds.

“Make History”

James Beatty is president of NCS International, a nationally recognized site selection and economic development firm based in Omaha, Nebraska. He is one of the nation's top site consultants for call centers, shared service centers, mission-critical facilities and back-office operations. He has led numerous initiatives in rural and urban America and was named one of America's top 50 consultants by Consultant Connection. James has worked on over 300 projects, representing 30,000+ jobs and \$3 billion in investment.



He has written extensively on economic development, including the widely used “Technology-Led Economic Development” manual, published by Verizon and the International Economic Development Council. He contributes to industry publications and is a frequent national speaker. His work has been featured in the Wall Street Journal, Atlanta Business Journal, Nations Business, and the New York Times.

James was appointed to the Congressional Office on U.S. Technology Assessment and is a former policy fellow and adjunct professor at the Docking Institute at Fort Hays State University. He also served as a national consultant on IT for the National Congress for Community and Economic Development in Washington, D.C.

He has delivered keynote speeches to the National Governors Association, the Aspen Institute, IEDC, and others, and has conducted workshops for thousands of economic development professionals.

Before founding NCS, James worked for Northwestern Bell (AT&T), branding Omaha as the “Nation's Capital for 800 and Toll-Free Numbers.”

He has served on many boards, including the Omaha Jaycees, Urban League of Nebraska, Durham Western Heritage Museum, Nebraska Economic Development Commission, United Way of the Midlands, and the Omaha Metro Transit Authority.

James's honors include induction into several halls of fame and Doane University's Paul Kersenbrock Humanitarian and Honor “D” awards. A 1970 Doane graduate and the first African American to major in mathematics, James and his wife, Earlene, established the Grant Hatchett Scholarship. They have five children, 11 grandchildren, and three great-grandchildren.
